The meetings will be mostly metro-focused, however, Colonel Edmonson as our SPOC and our LA FirstNet team will continue to push **rural needs as a priority**. While these FirstNet efforts are applauded – Louisiana remains a mostly rural state. **Rural buildout is not only required in the law– it's required by Louisiana stakeholders!**
