Data Collection is your way of informing the plan for the buildout of the Nationwide Public Safety Broadband Network (NPSBN) in Louisiana. Our survey (MDST) is currently active and open to all public safety agencies in the state, and the Broadband Working Group is meeting to identify coverage objectives and plan for capacity. FirstNet plans to issue a **request for proposals** (RFP) to work with potential offerors to build, operate, and maintain the nationwide public safety broadband network (NPSBN) and to acquire services and/or, potentially, **equipment** to provide Band 14 Long Term Evolution (LTE) services to public safety entities nationwide. The public safety community fought hard and lobbied Congress to pass legislation establishing a dedicated, reliable network for advanced data communications nationwide. During emergencies, emergency services personnel need priority access and preemption, which are not available on commercial networks.
