The FirstNet Board announced the restructuring of its senior management positions to more closely align with its mission and operating model by creating the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and President titles and appointing technology executive and former police captain Michael Poth as the new CEO of FirstNet. TJ Kennedy, who as Acting Executive Director has been successfully leading FirstNet during its startup phase, is functioning in the role of **President**.

U.S. Secretary of Commerce Penny Pritzker named four leading experts on public safety, wireless broadband communications, and state and local government to serve three-year terms on the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) Board. Kevin McGinnis and Annise Parker were both reappointed to the Board and the Board welcomed new members, Neil Cox and Edward Horowitz.

Did you know?

The Broadband Working Group was created by LA FirstNet to help identify coverage priorities and provide input into capacity planning for the phased buildout of the NPSBN.

Members include representatives from police, ambulance/emergency medical services providers, parish GIS experts, deputy sheriffs, IT professionals, and emergency managers.

The working group has identified coverage priorities that include: evacuation routes, crash locations, shelter locations, hospitals, correctional facilities, navigable waterways, ports, hazardous materials routes, among MANY others.
