



Statewide Interoperability Executive Committee



Authority

- La. R.S. 29 §725.6, Effective August 15, 2008
- Establishes the **Office of Interoperability within GOHSEP** and provides for a Deputy Director of Interoperability who will chair the Interoperability Subcommittee.
 - GOHSEP delegated the **maintenance of interoperability systems to the Louisiana State Police**
- Created the **Statewide Interoperability Executive Committee (SIEC)** which *reports* to the Unified Command Group on interoperability issues.

Authority

- Designing, constructing, and assisting in administering and maintaining a **statewide communications interoperability plan for first responders** with the ability to transport and receive voice, data, image and video information
 - ***Louisiana Wireless Information Network (LWIN)***
- **Coordinating interoperability issues** with emergency alert services, 911 services, 211 services, integrated criminal justice systems, as well as identifying other systems which may need to be addressed by the committee.



Statewide System Requirements

- 95% or better **portable radio coverage inside a building** within at least the more densely populated metropolitan areas (*9 areas*) of the state as defined in the SCIP, and
- 95% or better **portable radio street level coverage** in all other areas of the state.




